

### **CELL PHONE USE:**

There is absolutely no cell phone use in any classroom, including study hall and homeroom. This includes pagers, text messaging and phones in vibrate mode. Other electronic devices including IPODS, MP3 devices, radios, headphones, CD players will not be allowed to be used in the classroom, including study hall and homeroom. The use of cell phones and electronic devices is restricted to outside of the classroom, during lunch or between classes. Phones and electronic devices that are used during the class period will be confiscated. To minimize classroom disruption and the possibility of theft, we highly recommend that expensive devices such as, but not limited to, cell phones, IPODS, radios, headphones, tape players, MP3 players and CD players, not be brought to school. Anyone who uses a photo device or movie device to capture pictures of student(s) or staff without the permission of the school will be subject to discipline. Phones and other devices confiscated will be turned into the High School Office.

Students that do not abide by these rules will be subject to the following consequences:

- \* 1<sup>st</sup> violation - phone is taken away and returned at the end of the day.
- \* 2<sup>nd</sup> violation - phone is taken away and returned at the end of the day and In School Suspension
- \* 3<sup>rd</sup> violation - phone returned to parent and In-School Suspension

This rule holds true for someone “borrowing” another student’s phone and using it during school hours.
