

YME High School Removal from Class

Removal of a student from instructional class time is a serious situation. Students that are removed from class shall be subject to the following guidelines:

Removal from the same class: (i.e. – 3 removals from Civics 9)

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| 1 st removal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- conference with Principal- verbal warning of stated guidelines- return to class / remain in office (TBD by Principal) |
| 2 nd removal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- conference with Principal, teacher and student.- possible removal from class for duration of quarter/semester/year (TBD by Principal)- In School Suspension |
| 3 rd removal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- removal from class for duration of quarter/semester/year- Right of parental appeal – must be in writing and made made within three (3) days of notification of loss of credit. Student must appeal in person with the Principal to meet with the appeals committee. |

Removals from different classes shall be subject to the following guidelines: (i.e. – 1 removal from Civics 9, 1 removal from Chemistry 9, and 1 removal from PE 9)

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| 1 st removal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- conference with Principal- verbal warning of stated guidelines- return to class / remain in office (TBD by Principal) |
| 2 nd removal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- conference with Principal, teachers and student.- possible removal from class(es) for duration of quarter/semester/year- In School Suspension |
| 3 rd removal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Out of School Suspension |
| 4 th removal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- removal from class(es) removed from for duration of quarter/semester/year- Right of parental appeal – must be in writing and made within three (3) days of notification of loss of credit. Student must appeal in person with the Principal to meet with the appeals committee. |
